- Flowers open at night
  - White, pinkish purple, golden yellow, red-purple
  - Strong offensive odor from leaves
  - Sweet strong smell from flowers
  - Branches are strong and woody
  - Trumpet shape
  - High nectar-producing flower
- 
- Attracts: MOTHS



- Flowers open in the day
  - Yellow and red
  - Weak or no fragrance
  - Funnel-shaped with spur
  - Flowers are abundant in sweet nectar
- 
- Attracts: BIRDS



- Light green flowers with purple streaks
  - Funnel, deep bowl-shaped flower
  - Emits a rotten or musty smell at night
  - High nectar-producing flowers
  - Flowers open at night
- 
- Attracts: BATS

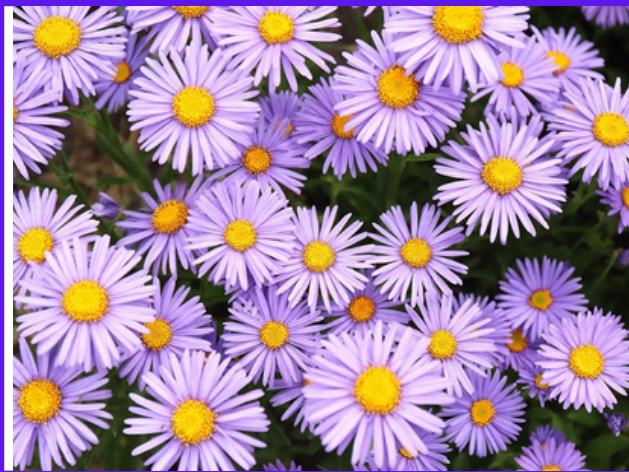

- Flowers during the day
- Flowers are purple, white, red, yellow
- Has offensive odor
- Trap-shaped flowers
- Male flowers have nectar and pollen
- Female flowers do not have any nectar or pollen
- Small bees cannot access the nectar
  
- Attracts: FLIES



- Flowers during the day
- Fragrant flowers
- Flowers are white, blue, purple, pink, yellow
- Globular-shaped flowers
- Abundant source of nectar
  
- Attracts: BUTTERFLIES



- Flowers open in the day
- Flower colors are white, pink, purple, red, blue
- High nectar-producing flowers
- Open, flat dish-shaped flowers
- Light to no fragrance
  
- Attracts: BEES



- Flowers open during the day
- Flowers are pink or white
- Shallow open bowl-shaped flowers
- Faint sweet fragrance
- Abundant source of nectar and pollen
  
- Attracts: BEETLES
